

2015 RISK MANAGEMENT GOALS

GOAL #1: The Executive Council and Risk Management Chairman will be responsible for creating an environment that is in compliance with Pi Kappa Phi's Risk Management Policy.

Examples:

- There will be no tables/paraphernalia within the fraternity house or at chapter events that give the appearance they are used for drinking games.
- There will be no keg/common source alcohol containers within the chapter facility or at chapter events.
- The chapter should consider establishing BYOB limits based on FIPG recommendations.
- The chapter should re-enforce proper associate member programming without alcohol.
- GOAL #2: The Risk Management Chairman will serve as an ex-officio member of the Executive Council.

GOAL #3: Each Risk Management Chairman, with input from the Executive Council, will develop written risk management procedures utilizing the Risk Management Policies and Procedures template.

GOAL #4: The chapter will focus on prevention and plan ahead in order to SAVE money and EARN money.

Pi Kappa Phi is pleased to be able to continue to offer a 10% discount for any chapter that prepays its risk management assessment IN FULL by May 21, 2015. Chapters should remit payment by that date in order to take advantage of this discount.

Pi Kappa Phi will also continue to convert a portion of our student premiums into a fund to reward good risk management and chapter leadership, so those chapters who are holding all brothers accountable are not being punished by subsidizing chapters that allow some brothers to put us all at risk. Chapters will be able to earn a 5% rebate at the end of the academic year if they meet the following criteria: (1) no risk management violation and/or claim; (2) current on all financial obligations to the National Fraternity; (3) timely submission of all pre-initiation and initiation cards and fees and Green Report; (4) full attendance and participation in Pi Kapp College for Chapter Officers and Supreme Chapter; and (5) completion of schedule risk management and alcohol education programs.
